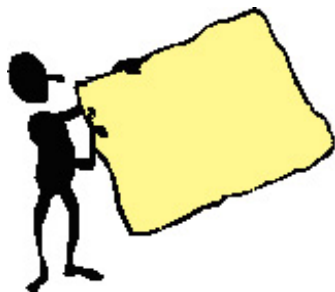
Jury's Hotel, Cork 6th – 7th November 2009

CALL FOR POSTERS

The Institute of Archaeologists of Ireland (IAI) are currently organising their Autumn Conference which will be held in Jury's Hotel in Cork on November 6th and 7th 2009. The conference aims to explore recent developments in Irish archaeology and will include a wide variety of papers on excavations, recent field discoveries and current research. A session of the management and archiving of digital data is also planned.



The Institute is currently organising a poster-display area where members of the Institute, conference sponsors and post-graduate students of archaeology may display posters which illustrate the nature of their research or highlight interesting aspects of their fieldwork, but **which need not necessarily address the conference theme**. Posters should be A1 or A0 in size, should be printed on a single sheet of good quality paper and should, ideally, be composed of a combination of text (600-1,000 words) and high quality colour or greyscale images.



Members of the IAI Conference Sub-Committee will hang the posters on the display boards on the evening of Thursday 5th and on the morning of Friday 6th November and the posters will then be on public display for the remainder of the conference. A prize will be awarded to the best poster displayed by a post-graduate student.
